BID BRIEF

EVENT OVERVIEW

The Level 9 Eastern and Western Championships include competitions for Level 9 athletes. A host city can anticipate a delegation size of approximately 1000 people, which includes athletes, coaches, judges, and staff. The competition format includes three days of competition, which determines the All-Around, Individual Event, and Regional Team winner for each of the sixteen age divisions at Easterns and at Westerns.

This event will require the Host / LOC to partner with a local women's gymnastics expert and / or local gymnastics club to fulfill the technical responsibilities and to provide a volunteer force.

BID PROCEDURE

Interested parties should complete the Intent to Bid and submit it to Annie Heffernon, Women's Junior Olympic Program Director (<u>aheffernon@usagym.org</u>) and Jordan Dillon, Director of Junior Olympic Events (<u>jdillon@usagym.org</u>) no later than March 9, 2018. A separate Intent to Bid must be submitted for each year in which you intend to bid. Please do not provide any information other than what is asked for on the Intent to Bid form as it will not be considered.

Finalists will receive complete bid books and be asked to submit complete bid proposals no later than April 13, 2018.

VENUE SPECIFICATIONS

The facility should be a modern, clean and accessible arena or convention center exhibit space meeting the following minimum standards:

- Training Hall Floor Area: 90' wide x 130' long, 25' minimum ceiling height
- Competition Floor Area: 90' wide x 200' long to be divided into two competitive gyms, 25' ceiling
- Spectator Seating: 1,000 stadium type
- Preferred Internet Speed: 25mbps down/10 mbps up

HOTEL

A graduated room block as shown below will be needed. A single hotel is preferred, and the proximity to the venue is greatly valued. All hosts and hotels are required to work with National Travel Systems (NTS), our travel partner for all negotiation, contract and room block management for the entire process. All hotels are required to work with the NTS' branded National Sales Office, however NTS deems necessary. NTS will generate all RFP's through the hotel brand's global sales office (when applicable) and hotels will be required to respond in kind. NTS agrees to copy hosts on all initial RFPs. Host should not hold rooms blocks or contract room blocks on their own.
